

Project: New Sports Facility, Community Facility & Parks Depot, Hackney, N1

This project was undertaken as a series of phased works on an existing Parks Depot site, to create a new Changing Rooms Building and 3-court external MUGA (Multi-Use Games Area) for use by The Bridge Academy and the local community, and included providing a new depot for the Parks Department of The London Borough of Hackney. M&E Services Installations were provided individual to each building and included underfloor heating, MUGA floodlighting and rainwater harvesting.
