Recent & Current Projects



Claremont Fan Court School (£5 Million) - Due to Start January 2017. Client - Claremont Fan Court School; Architect – Fletcher Crane Architects; Project Manager - Richardson Greenyer

The project includes a new BREEAM 'Very Good' Science and Technology building providing new Science Laboratories and Teaching Spaces along with a new Workshop Building and refurbishment of an existing Workshop Building. The project will also provide Infrastructure for further buildings adjacent to the site and increased car parking.

Brooklands College (Weybridge Campus) (£6.7 Million) - Completion due Winter 2017. Client - Brooklands College; Architect – Bond Bryan; Project Manager - Fusion PM Ltd

Extensive infrastructure and refurbishment works are being undertaken at the Weybridge Campus for Brooklands College. These include the replacement of the aged electrical infrastructure, works to the aged wiring within the listed buildings, refurbishment of part of the Catering Department and the refurbishment of teaching spaces to part of the site. In association with these projects there is the construction of a new Sports Hall and Construction Trades Building at the College campus in Ashford, Middlesex.



41 Great Pulteney Street (£2.8 Million) - Completion due Summer 2017. Client - Sir Richard Sutton Estates Ltd; Architect – Rolfe Judd.



The new building will comprise 4 floors of offices over 3No. retail units at Ground Floor. The Office floors were subject to a stripping out contract to enable further investigations to allow the addition of the fourth floor. The services installations will include new gas fired VRF systems with ventilation, domestic services and electrical and fire alarm installations to form a high specification office building in the centre of Soho, London.
