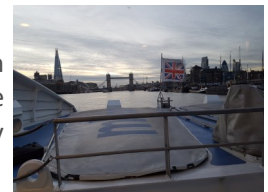
### Latest News

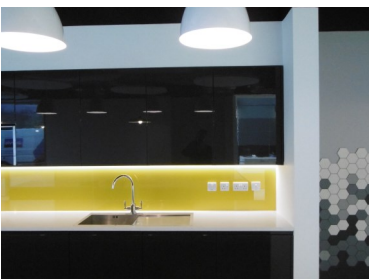

**Project Viewpoint One - Completed March 2017; Client - Boulton Brooks Real Estate; Architect - Gpad London Ltd; Contractor - Jarvis Contracting Ltd**

Complete strip-out of the M&E services to the existing buildings, then re-clad, provided with new false floor installations and new exposed M&E services installations throughout, to a Cat A standard.
